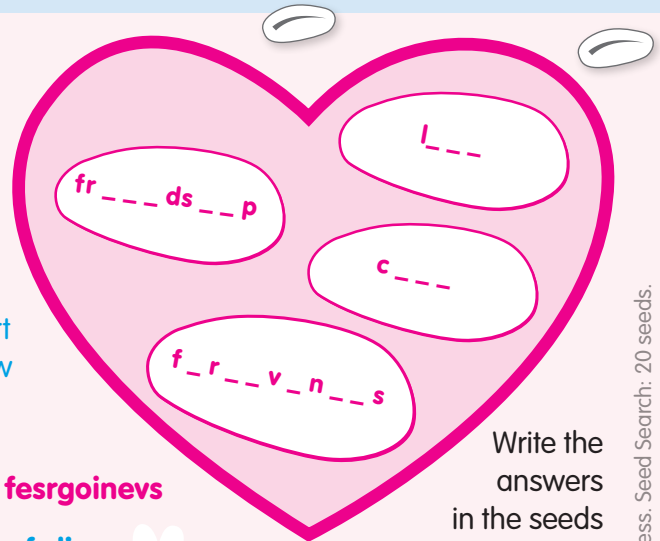
A HUG

The birds are coming! How many seeds can you quickly count on this sheet? Colour them all in.

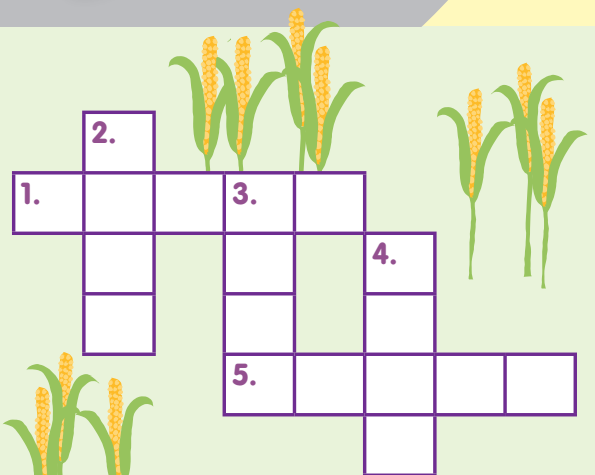


A PRAYER TO SAY
