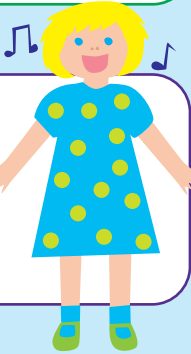

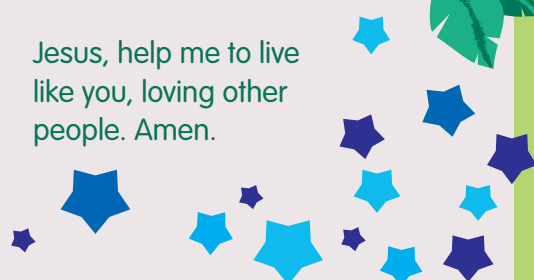

 people. Amen.



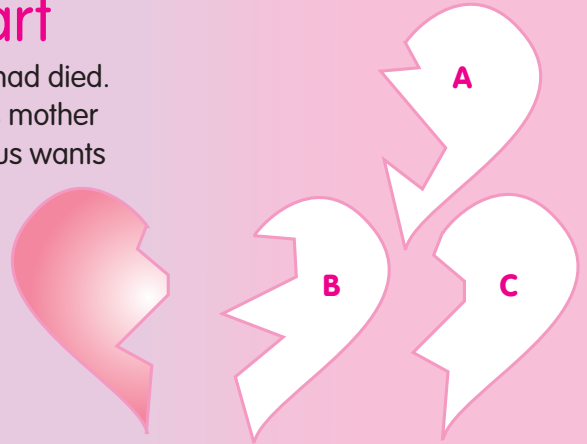
An only son has died, leaving his mother all alone. Jesus is sad for her and brings her son back to life! Everyone praises God!

 to make everyone better.

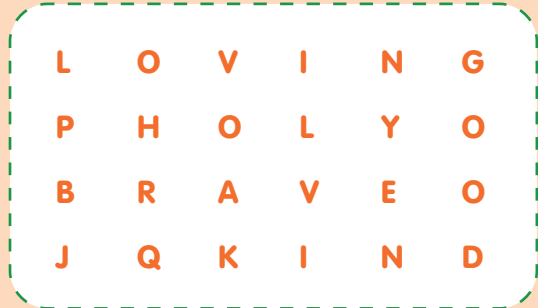
Which piece will mend the

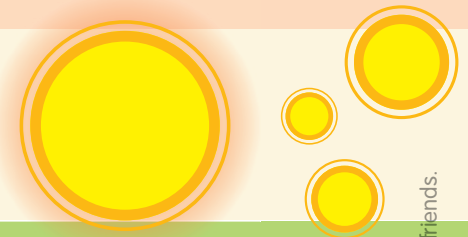
