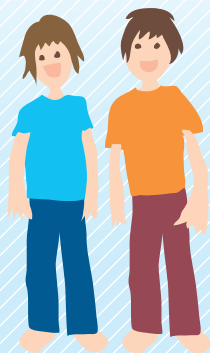
What do you need to go on a long journey? Draw a line from the things you need, to the rucksack.
